

Foreign Language Library for Adults: Learning German



WHAT DOES THE “LEARNING GERMAN” SECTION OFFER?

- The “Learning German” section facilitates the approach to the German language for all those who speak a foreign language.
- We offer German courses for all stages, accompanying texts to courses and autodidactic courses on various media. There are also bilingual German courses in the departure languages, dictionaries, simple German texts in book form, on audio CDs and bilingual texts.
- Information on German courses in Winterthur and its surroundings is available.
- Special desks, PC and internet stations are reserved for those who wish to learn German by themselves in the library.

WHO MAY USE THE FOREIGN LANGUAGE LIBRARY?

- Like the whole library net, the Foreign Language Library is open to the entire population of the Winterthur area.
- The library addresses itself primarily to adults who want to improve their language abilities, especially their knowledge of German.
- Instructors will find books for teaching German as a second or foreign language.

HOW CAN ONE USE THE FOREIGN LANGUAGE LIBRARY?

- Adults pay an annual fee of 50 francs (students: 40) and have all library assets at their disposal. The use of assets inside the library is free.
- The Winterthur Library Card is available at the service desk on the main floor of the City Library and in all branch libraries.
- The books of the “Learning German” section can be found on the second floor (OG2) of the City Library, as well as internet computers and further PC work stations.
- The library staff is happy to help with any questions about utilisation.
- Suggestions for the purchase of new books can be made at the information desk on the second floor.
