

Internet use

Dear Internet User

The rules on internet use at the „Stadtbibliothek Winterthur“ will change starting from 09/02/2009.

After 09/02/2009, you will need a „[Stadtbibliothek Winterthur](#)“ [library card](#) in order to access the internet from our PC workstations. A personal membership costs CHF 8.– . The card will be issued to you at the Reception Desk on the ground floor.

After you receive your card, you need to register at the staff desk on the second floor.

To log on, you enter the bar code number on your library card and your personal PIN (date of birth in four digits).

You will have an allowance of [30 minutes online time](#) every day. You can use the 30 minutes in one session or divide them up into several shorter sessions throughout the day.

Should there be no workstation available, you may draw a number and wait in the waiting area until another cardholder's session is up. The person with the lowest number gets the next free workstation.

If you only need to use the internet on a single occasion, please turn to our staff for assistance.

The advantages of this system are:
